HOW TO GET A PRIVATE METER

Where to buy a meter

Meters are available for purchase here at the sewer district office at 80 Marshview Ln in Ogunquit, but you are not required to buy one here. The only requirement is that the meter be in <u>CUBIC FEET</u>. If you end up buying the meter elsewhere, please call the office to let us know you bought one and provide us with the meter's serial number.

Which meter set up would I need?

<u>Irrigation system</u>: You will need a water meter with 2 couplings and will probably need to have your irrigation company or plumber install it.

Outside hand watering with a hose: You will need a water meter with 2 connectors and a leader hose. No plumber required. You just screw it onto your outside water spigot, and attach your hose to the other end. If you will only be doing a small amount of hand watering, (like for a few flower pots) it may not be worth buying a meter.

Cost of meters:

\$130.00 (meter with couplings and/or a leader hose) \$100.00 (meter only, to replace a broken meter)

Method of payment:

Check (payable to Ogunquit Sewer District), cash or a bill can be mailed to you.

Who do I call to arrange to pick up a meter?

The administrative office is staffed by only one employee, so please contact Debbie (207-646-2028 or debbie@ogunquitsewerdistrict.org) before coming to pick up a meter, in the event she is away from the office. Office hours are typically Monday – Friday, 8 am - 2 pm. If Debbie's not in, she can make arrangements to have a meter ready for you to pick up during plant hours (Mon – Fri, 7 am - 3 pm).

Directions to Ogunquit Sewer District:

- From Ogunquit, head north on Rt 1, to the light by New England House & Spinnakers.
- Take a right onto Bourne Ave & go .7 miles.
- At the stop sign, take a right onto Ocean Ave & go .4 miles to North Beach Parking Lot.
- Go straight thru the parking lot and we're located at the end of the dead-end road.
