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PRIVATE METER POLICY

(Irrigation Systems~Well Water~Ice Machines~Pool or Hot Tubs~Hand Watering)

Effective September 6, 2016, the Board of Trustees of the Ogunquit Sewer District has revised their policy with regards to your private meter.

THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY!

We are no longer accepting readings for meters that measure in GALLONS. Cubic foot meters are available for purchase at the District.

Private meter reporting will **ONLY** be accepted on a **District form** via:
Mail, Email, or by on-line submission. Forms will be mailed to you the end of September.

The following will **NOT** be accepted (including but not limited to):
Forms turned in late, faxes, walk-ins, call-ins, inaccurate readings, incomplete forms and readings from gallon meters.

Credit for lawn meter use is for the current year only. (If a reading was not turned in for one or more years, the total usage will be divided accordingly. For proper credit, please turn your form in each year with the current reading, even if the meter was not used for that year.) Check your meter periodically to be sure it is working. If it stops or breaks mid-season and is not replaced, you will only receive credit for use during the measured period.

There will be no abatements for meters turned in late or not turned in at all, incorrect meter readings or any other situation where an accurate, timely reading is not received. Un-metered water usage, such as filling a hot tub or swimming pool will not be abated. Meters may be borrowed from the District for this purpose. There will be no exceptions to this policy and no requests for abatements may be presented to the Board.

It is the property owner's responsibility to adhere to these policies and to properly report information.

Deadline for reporting a private meter reading: November 30th of each year.
